## Awsaj Academy honours class of 2013

Doha, June 9<sup>th</sup>,2013: Ten graduates recently received their diplomas from Awsaj Academy, representing yet another milestone as the institution marked its eighth graduation ceremony.

The event was held on Wedensday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at the auditorium of Awsaj Academy, part of Qatar Foundation for Education, Science and Community Development. It was attended by parents, students, staff and several distinguished guests, including Mr Fahad Al-Subaiey, CEO of Hassad Food and Chair of the Board of Governors of Awsaj Academy; Mr. Abdulrahman M. The pre-ceremony featured a musical piece performed by *Marasi*, a band from Qatar Music Academy, whose prowess mesmerised the audience. The ceremony then officially began with the Qatari National Anthem followed by the reciting of the Holy Qur'an by graduating seniors Abdulla Bahzad and Fahad Al Naimi.

In his welcoming address, Dr. Ralph Pruitt, Director of Awsaj Academy, paid tribute to the graduates by saying, "Today you are leaving with a diploma that is recognised by colleges around the world. You have been successful due to your perseverance and desire to achieve in order to meet an important goal."
