

## JAPANESE PEACE BOAT VISITS QATAR FOUNDATION

**Doha, Qatar, 15 September 2015:** Qatar Foundation for Education, Science and Community Development (QF) played host to 120 visitors from the Japanese 'Peace Boat' on Monday.

The visit to QF was part of the inaugural trip to Qatar for the 'Peace Boat'. Director and Founder of the 'Peace Boat' Yoshioka Tatsuya, said: "I am impressed with Qatar Foundation, especially its efforts in education, which is helping Qatar shift from a fossil-fuel society to a knowledge-based economy.
