



ROTA LAUNCHES 10TH ANNUAL RAMADAN VOLUNTEER PROJECT

Partnering with Local Organisations to Deliver '10 Years of Service' Campaign

Doha, Qatar, 23 May 2016: Reach Out To Asia (ROTA) has officially announced its Ramadan 2016 Project, '10 Years of Service', which will include activities that support construction workers, the elderly, and other local groups in Qatar.

The announcement came during a press conference held on Sunday, and speakers included Mohammed Al Naama, Acting Executive Director, Reach Out To Asia (ROTA), and Stephen Kelly, President and General Manager of Occidental Petroleum of Qatar Ltd. (Oxy Qatar), the project's exclusive sponsor.

Teams of ROTA volunteers will, once again, reach out to various groups to make a positive and tangible impact in their lives. Mr Stephen Kelly said: "Oxy Qatar is honoured to support ROTA's annual Ramadan Project, as it is an important part of our corporate social responsibility programme.
