

HEC Paris in Qatar and Qatar Science and Technology Park MoU to cooperate on mutual education, research and training services

Doha, Qatar – October 26, 2016: HEC Paris in Qatar, one of the world's top three providers of Executive Education programs, has signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with Qatar Science and Technology Park (QSTP) as part of the Doha campus' efforts to promote the importance of a knowledge-based economy.

This MoU comes at a time when QSTP has retailored its support programmes to further streamline business commercialization of products and services developed by tech entrepreneurs in Qatar who are driven by innovation. Thus, the synergies with HEC Paris in Qatar are quite promising."

Employees, students and faculty members affiliated with both HEC Paris in Qatar and QSTP will benefit from research, educational and training opportunities as a result of this agreement.
