'The Blue Jackal' Book Launch Attended By More Than 150 Children And Their Families

Doha, Qatar, 28 June 2014: Qatar National Library, (QNL) in collaboration with Occidental Petroleum of Qatar Ltd. (Oxy Qatar) recently welcomed more than 150 children and their families to 'The Blue Jackal' book launch. The event, which took place last week, reflects QNL's commitment to keeping local traditions alive and encouraging young people to preserve Qatar's heritage.
